Safe Play Procedures – Free Play Times

The Playscape is specifically designed for children 4 years through 12 years. During Preschool Playdays, the Playscape is reserved exclusively for children Kindergarten and younger. Children younger than 4 years will be allowed on the Playscape under direct supervision of their parent or guardian. Parents are highly encouraged to play on the structure with their children.

"Parent Supervision" specifically means this is a parent supervised time. Parents are asked to keep children in their sight and help them observe the Safe Play Procedures in order to maintain a safe play environment.

In order to maintain the highest levels of safe play, a maximum of 150 children and adults will be allowed in the Children's Building during Free Play times.

For the safety of the children and maintenance of the equipment there should be no food, drinks, candy or gum in the play areas at any time. This does not include nursing or bottle fed infants.

Please do not bring any toys or objects into the Playscape area.

Shoes are to be removed and placed in the shoe racks for all children and adults playing on the Playscape structure. When playing on the Playscape socks, hose or suitable foot coverings should be worn at all times.

Please, no running in the Playscape or Reception Area.

No climbing, hanging or swinging on the netting, support poles or outside of the equipment.

Slide down the slides only seated and feet first. Running up the slide can be hazardous.

Please follow any instruction or direction given by a Preschool Ministry Team representative.

The inability to follow the above instructions and maintain levels of safe play could result in being excluded from Free Play times.
